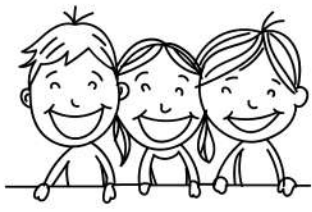

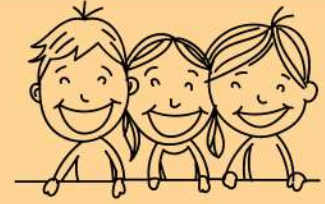

Reclaim farmer folk music

16:30 - 18:15

The battle of farmer folk music - can the left reclaim this? Extreme right strategically infuses folk music about farmers with xenophobia, sexism and conservatism, to push for extreme right agendas. However, this folk music has been sung over centuries. In this workshop, we'll delve into the intricate matter of how to make antifascist folk music and we will revive some of the old, almost forgotten songs. Through reviving them with the air from our vocal cords, we'll explore how they could spark agroecological system change. This workshop is also an excellent opportunity to give input on the Agroecological Album Toekomstboeren is working on.

Reclaim the foodsystem: introduction to agroecology

13:30 - 14:15

In this workshop Darleen (Agro ecology netwerk) and Marcha (stichting Boerengroep) will dive into agroecology with you. They will give a short overview of the development of industrial agriculture and countermovements that were arising, of which agroecology is a beautiful example. Agroecology is not only a farming practice, it's a set of principles which imply that agroecology is not just about creating food, it's about a just, ecological and autonomous connection to society, the land and farming. You will not only learn about the concept agro-ecology, but the workshop will also give you space to discuss how you could include agroecological transformation in your life and thereby contribute to a wider just food system.

Workshops:

Reclaim the seeds

16:30 - 17:30

English

Generation after generation of farmers saved a part of their crop to plant in the next year. These plants got used to their unique surroundings, but with industrial agriculture these seeds got patented and modified. Now saving a seed will result in a crooked off-spring. During this workshop we will talk about the history of seed saving and why it is important for biodiversity and resilience. We will collect seeds from various plants and bulbs, which you can take home and grow yourself. After this we can exchange some seeds at the seed-sharing stand!

Reclaim the weeds

16:30 - 18:30

This workshop will reclaim all the plants that are deemed unwanted. We will walk through the Nettle garden and identify plants that are often categorized as weeds. We will start with a short introduction on how this categorisation accelerated in 20th century Netherlands and how this alienation influences the way we see modern agriculture. During the walk we can eat some plants and share some of the ways they are beneficial for insects and how we can use them in the kitchen.

Together we will analyze the food system in its complexity with all its different stakeholders. Who's actually holding the power? How are all the dots connected? We'll put our knowledge and insights together to create an overview and we'll start thinking from there what our won role in it is and how to improve the system.
